

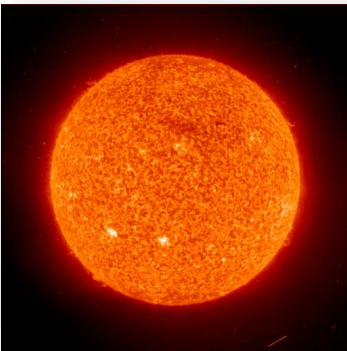


The Wild World of Weather!

Choices for 2011 – 2012!

1. ***The Water Cycle, Clouds and Storms.*** Reinforce what the students are already learning about the water cycle using stimulating imagery, severe weather video and graphic animation while covering all the terms that the students need to know for their tests. You'll love the tornado videos and the kids will be talking about the twisters for days afterward.



Also in this presentation... The sun has been much weaker than usual and we'll look at the latest images from satellites that generate images of the sun every day. The colors are amazing and the students learn more about how the sun impacts our weather and climate.

2. ***Severe Storms and Severe Weather Safety.*** Violent storms killed more than 600 people in 2011 and caused billions of dollars in damage! As our population increases, more people and property are exposed to risk, but there are ways to better understand and prepare for severe storms. We'll learn about the different kinds of severe weather, where and when it strikes and how to keep you and your students and their families safe.
